198 The Empty Tomb

▷ In Lk's account of the Resurrection, he focuses on what the women see.

Many mag., Joanna
Mary - mother of James/Jn

▷ Jc's Resurrection from Lk.

- Joseph of Arimathea gave Jc ^{his} ~~the~~ tomb b/c he disagreed w/ what the council had done to Jc
- women came w/ spice & oils to prepare Jc's body on 1st day of week (Sunday)
- Found rolled away stone & empty tomb
- 2 men in dazzling garments said "Why do you seek the living one amongst the dead? He is not here, but he has been raised..."
- They run to tell the apostle
- Apostles don't believe them
- Peter goes to the tomb to find out himself

199 He Has Been Raised

▷ Lk's gospel focuses on Jc's appearance to 2 disciples on the Rd to Emmaus

↳ Jc walks w/ them & discusses

Scripture, but they don't recognize him until the breaking of bread (euch. meal)

↳ lesson on the meaning of the Euch.

↳ God is present in both scrip. & sacramental sign of bread/wine

↓
Jc becomes the bread = he disappears

Model for Mass
1) Lit of Word
2) Lit of Euch.

199 ... He Has Been Raised

▷ After Res. → Jc told disc. → future ministry
↳ stay in Jer. until you receive power
from on High

↳ even though his time on earth would soon be over, he promised he would still be with them

↙
Ascension → moment when
Jc, in Res. body, returned
to Fr. in Heaven. He will
come again @ end of time

"I Will Come Back to You"

▷ Jc had a special mission for disc. → spread the
message of salvation

▷ Jc prepared them for when he wouldn't be with them

- "The Advocate, the H.S., will teach you
& remind you of all I've told you"

- "Don't be troubled/afraid... I will be back"

Called to Sense

▷ We too receive the grace of the HS = a gift
to help us cooperate w/ God's plan for salvation

▷ By the power of the H.S. → we can merit ^{for us & others}
the graces needed for everlasting life (Heaven)
